



Elementary	17 (.3%)	0 – 1.7%
Middle	204 (9.1%)	8.9 – 9.4%
High	117 (4.5%)	4.0 – 4.9%

Chronic Absenteeism: January – June 2023




Grantees Reporting Chronic Absenteeism

School level	# (%) students chronically absent	Range: chronic absenteeism rates
Elementary	1175 (20.5%)	6.2 – 32.8%
Middle	206 (9.2%)	6.2 – 11.9%
High	430 (16.5%)	9.0 – 23.9%
