# **Purpose of The Evaluation**

- Evaluations show change from programs and interventions.
- This evaluation data can be used to
  - Compare outcomes before and after implementation.
  - Establish that a program works to achieve outcomes.
  - Identify challenges to implementation and solutions for improvement.
  - Support health equity.
  - Support replication, expansion, growth, and sustainability!



# What Kind of Evaluation?

- Outcome evaluation numbers, data
  - Evaluator receives the data from the pilot sites
  - Document change at the school-level
- Process evaluation interviews
  - Evaluator "collects" the data directly from the grantee staff
  - Document challenges, solutions, lessons learned in implementation
  - Inform best practices
- These will happen concurrently.



# **Evaluation Process Overview**

#### <u>Phase 1 – Develop the evaluation outcome framework</u>

- Establish the specific outcomes measures, including ---
  - Align where possible across sites, with DESE requirements, with other existing data collections
  - Define the indicators as needed (ex: family satisfaction)
  - What data are available??
  - Conversations with each pilot site and MAMH
- Establish data collections roles/processes at each site



# **Evaluation process overview**

#### Phase 2 – Outcome data collection and analysis

- Grantees will work with their school partners to collect and receive the data (i.e., list of suspensions) → provide those data to Evaluator
- Grantees will collect their own internal data (i.e., referrals) → provide those data to Evaluator
- Evaluator to provide technical assistance to the grantees
