SCHOOL & COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES

The Children's Room's School and Community-Based Services provide students access to quality, trauma-informed grief support in their familiar, daily environments. TCR is available year round to discuss our menu of services and the needs of your school and/or community agency.

<u>DIRECT SERVICES FOR STUDENTS:</u> Provided through collaborations between clinical staff from TCR and mental health professionals from the school or community agency. Coordination, materials, and facilitation of these services are offered free of charge.

SCHOOL & COMMUNITY-BASED PEER SUPPORT GROUPS

- A customized, eight-week grief group series based on a peer support model
- Normalizes grief-related experiences, decreases isolation, strengthens coping skills, and builds connections among students
- Offered for 1st 12th graders who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling, or close family member



PATHWAYS OF CHANGE

- A four-part social and emotional learning curriculum focusing on change, loss, and grief
- Incorporates art, writing, group-based games, and psychoeducation
- Developed through the support of the Parmenter Foundation
- Offered for 2nd 4th graders

Pathways of Change CONNECTING TO HOPE & BUILDING RESILIENCE

CHILDREN'S & TEENS' GRIEF AWARENESS MONTH

- School-wide tabling events with brief, collaborative activities
- Students show support for peers and increase awareness of grief on a community level
- Offered for 1st 12th graders
- Workshops also available for 9th 12th graders



<u>SERVICES FOR PROFESSIONALS:</u> Education and training regarding grief-sensitive practices within schools and agencies.

PROFESSIONAL TRAININGS


- In-depth understanding of ways to be supportive of students and families who are coping with death and/or other types of loss
- Typically a minimum of 2 hours in length, either virtually or on-site

PRESENTATIONS

- Raise awareness of the prevalence and impact of childhood and adolescent bereavement
- Gain understanding of services and partnerships available from The Children's Room

PROFESSIONAL CONSULTATIONS

- Focused on the grief-related needs of a specific client/student
- Discuss strategies for offering support within the context of the school or agency (ex: developmentally-appropriate responses to grief communication with the family, and planning for a student's return to school)
